If you prefer to arrive earlier than Wednesday, please let ride management know asap! Cell phone coverage is extremely limited in ride camp, and it doesn't seem to matter what provider you use. Please plan accordingly.

ALL RIDERS ARE REQUIRED TO WEAR PROPER FOOTWEAR WHEN HANDLING ANY HORSES. ALL RIDERS ARE REQUIRED TO WEAR A HELMET AT ALL TIMES WHILE MOUNTED ON A HORSE. IF YOUR HORSE IS OVERLY FRACTIOUS OR AGGRESSIVE, YOU MAY BE ASKED TO PULL YOUR ENTRY AND LEAVE.

CAMP ETIQUETTE & RULES

- ❖ Park/camp in an orderly manner. We have many rigs showing up. We need to conserve space!
 - Please follow the directions of the Parking Volunteer.
- ❖ Contain your pets safely.
 - **No loose dogs in camp.** Dogs must be leashed or contained, please.
- ❖ No fires. Please join us at the central fire pit near the vet area!
- ❖ All generators are expected to be turned off by 10 p.m. each night.
- ❖ Good sportsmanship and common courtesy is expected from all who attend our rides, *at all times*.

PRE-RIDE MEETING

- ❖ 5:30 p.m. ~ Pre-ride meeting for the 75 and 100 mile riders on Friday evening.
- ❖ 7:00 p.m. ~ Pre-ride meeting for all other distances, each evening.

VETERINARY CRITERIA

- ❖ Vetting will begin Thursday afternoon after the vets arrive and are set up.
- ❖ Pulse criteria for every vet check and final vet in will be 60 beats per minute on all distances. ○ Pulse criteria must be met within 30 minutes of arriving at a vet check and the finish line.
- ❖ Horses entered in the 25 miler will get their placing when their horse reaches 60 bpm. ❖ A veterinarian's call on any pull is always the final word.
- ❖ Any horse requiring treatment by the veterinarians will enter a private treaty between the treating veterinarian and the horse's owner/representative.

VET CHECKS

- ❖ Give your number to the In Timer, upon your arrival into a vet check.
- ❖ Proceed to the pulsing area.
 - Ample water and sponge buckets will be provided at each vet check and pulse areas.
- ❖ After your horse reaches pulse criteria, proceed to the vetting area.

AWARDS

- ❖ Awards will be done when we know that most everyone is finished with their distances.

BEFORE YOU LEAVE

- ❖ Please clean up your campsite and haul out your trash.
- ❖ Spread your hay & manure. **DO NOT PILE YOUR HORSE'S MANURE!**
- ❖ Please fill any holes your horse may have dug while you were camped.

GPS TRACKS

- ❖ All of the tracks for this ride are available to download.
- ❖ We highly recommend you download the Ride with GPS PRIOR to arriving in camp, as cell service is spotty to nonexistent at the Outback Station.
